## **ITEM 3: ONGOING ACTIVITIES**

#### **Ongoing activities**

During our meeting we found that we want to speed things up a bit concerning the four parts in the headline above. So we decided to have one sub-project leader for each of those sub-projects.

- Nordnet: Sub-project leader: Frode Koppang. Point of contacts: Casper Jepsen, Anders Frisk.

- NorDPOS: Sub-project leader: Casper Jepsen. Point of contacts: Gro Grinde, Anders Frisk.

- Exchange of data: Sub-project leader: Andreas Engfeldt. Point of contacts: Rune Hanssen, Örjan Zackrisson.

- Nordic Web portal: Sub-project leader: Casper Jepsen. Point of contacts: Tom Halvorsen, Anders Frisk, Frands Steffensen.

It was decided that the sub-project leader shall follow up the activities between the telephone and the "physical" meetings of the Steering Committee with necessary contacts (telephone or mail) and make a status report (oral or written) to each meeting of the Steering Committee. The report shall include how many meetings which have taken place, plans, what's performed, etc.

One way to speed things up is also to have a closer contact between the persons in the subproject. A proposal is to have a telephone meeting about every second week in each of the sub-projects.

#### Nordnet

The VPN line:

Since last meeting we have signed a Telenor offer for a computer network between the control centres. We have also cancelled the old agreement with Tele Danmark and the last day we can use the old computer network is the 31<sup>st</sup> of March, 2007. This means that the



new computer network MUST be up in good time before that date. The cost for the new lines will be splitted into three equal parts.

#### Nordic Web Portal

On December 19, 2006, there was a meeting in Gävle between Casper, Rune, Tom Halvorsen and Anders Frisk. One more possible problem has been identified, the programming language. On January 31, 2007, there will be another meeting in this sub group, this time also containing Frands Steffensen and Flemming Nissen. The whole portal shall be finished in April.

#### NorDPOS

In Denmark some problems with Trimble and RTCM 3.0 has been found. The problems seems to be less using GSM than using DAB. Anyway, now it is possible to test DAB in a small area with a predefined virtual reference station.

#### NordRTK

The was a meeting in NordRTK on January 23 in Arlanda (See Appendix A). Participants were Casper, Gro Grinde and Peter Wiklund. The next meeting will take place in København, probably on June 12. There will be a NordRTK meeting twice a year and now when Per Erik has left this sub group, Casper was appointed chair.

#### The national GPS services in each country

#### Denmark

Still KMS is checking/controlling the coordinates of the permanent GNSS stations owned by the private companies. In order to do that KMS is interested in the Swedish monitor station approach to check the private networks through, which means that KMS wants some advice from Lantmäteriet.

Norway

Within two months the three new CPOS-stations and the new DPOS-station in coastal Trøndelag will be up. This year there will be 12-16 new stations between Tromsø and Alta. There are also plans to build a few stations around Bodø and Lofoten, but those will first be built after the stations mentioned before.

#### Sweden

On January 1 the one-year establishment Network RTK project "Position Mitt" was finished.

There is a plan for 25 new Network RTK stations in the area of Jämtlands län and Västernorrlands län to tie together the northern network to the network in the southern



half of Sweden. The start of that project will hopefully be in August 2007. There are also an interest from a number of users to increase the area of the northern network with at least four stations.

Cartesia are no longer the operator of the EPOS service (DGPS) since January 1 2007. Teracom is at moment negotiating with another operator to keep the service in operation. The users will still be able to use the service until April 1, 2007, if no new operator has been found.

#### Approval of the performed classification of the reference stations

The document was approved and is up on the NKG-website since January 9, 2007.

#### **ITEM 4: FUTURE ACTIVITIES**

#### **GLOBALSTAR**:

No new modem has been developed. Bo will contact them about it one more time.

#### **ITEM 5: THE AUTOMATED COMPUTATION SERVICE**

The special version of the automated computation service for road construction (and especially for the "Road 45" project) is now in operation. A file of 30 minutes now gives a standard deviation of 10 mm. The next step is to make this work on national basis. Hopefully this will happen during the spring.

Lotti Jivall visited Statens Kartverk last autumn to inform about Swedish experiences on the set-up the Bernese software.

There were thoughts about creating a Nordic Bernese group, but we decided that such a proposal or decision shall not come from this group.

#### **ITEM 6: SPIDERNET TESTS**

Maybe there won't be a comparison with GPSNet in Denmark.

Probably there will be a Spidernet installation in Göteborg (Göteborg Positionerings System).



# ITEM 7: REPORT FROM THE LATEST PRESIDIUM MEETING AND PREPARATION FOR THE NEXT PRESIDIUM MEETING

The latest meeting of the Presidium took place on 30-31 October, 2006, in Akranes, Iceland. Because Bjørn will retire in 2007, the Presidium appointed Bo to be the new chair of Nordic Positioning Service.

The next meeting of the Presidium will take place on March 8-9 in Helsinki. One of the members of the Steering Committee who also is a member of the Presidium will inform the Presidium about our ongoing activities.

#### **ITEM 8: PREPARATION FOR THE NEXT DIRECTORS GENERAL MEETING**

The next Directors General meeting will take place this spring. On that meeting the total coverage of permanent reference stations for GNSS will be shown. Since NKG General Assembly we have an updated map of the permanent reference stations which belongs to the governmental agencies in the Nordic countries. But on this meeting also the permanent reference stations owned by private companies should be included, so we need to find out the rough coordinates of these. Casper has got the ones in Denmark and Bo has tried to get the ones in Finland. Bo will continue to try to get them by calling Seppo Tötterström. Casper is responsible for drawing the map, which means that all coordinates should be sent to him.

#### ITEM 9: EGNOS

Three satellites (120, 124 and 126) are sending out the signal. Since the ionosphere grid is densified, the accuracy has increased in the northern parts.
