



Call for nominations for the

NKG Award 2026

The Nordic Geodetic Commission Award recognises continuous outstanding contribution to geodesy in the Nordic/Baltic area, i.e. the countries of Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Latvia, Lithuania, Iceland, Norway, and Sweden. The purpose of the Award is to highlight important contributions as data collection, processing and finalization to the final product, cross-border projects and significant dedication for the benefit of the NKG in longer term.

A Candidate is geodesists and/or experts in the field of geodesy and related disciplines in Nordic/Baltic area.

The NKG Award will be presented at the NKG General Assembly in Vilnius, Lithuania, to be held 14 -17 of September 2026. The NKG Awardee will receive a NKG honorary diploma and memorabilia, and will be invited to give the “NKG Asplund Lecture

Nominations for the Award shall be submitted to the NKG Secretary Ivars Liepiņš (Ivars.Liepins@lgia.gov.lv) by 15 May 2026, 23:59 CEST. Only members of the NKG can nominate candidates for the Award. Self-nominations are not accepted. NKG Presidium members are not eligible to be candidates for the NKG Award during their terms of service.

Nominations should be written in English and include the following items:

- The full name, address, age, academic and/or professional qualifications and position of the candidate;
- Motivation for the nomination (~one page) including a general summary of the candidate's contribution to NKG;
- A curriculum vitae and list of relevant publications;
- Support letters.
